This Oral Hearing has been necessitated due to the reason that the then Designated Authority at the time of first Oral Hearing held on 30th July 2020, has been succeeded by new Designated Authority. This development mandates that a new oral hearing be held by the current Designated Authority as per the judgment of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the matter of Automotive Tyre Manufacturer’s Association (ATMA) vs Designated Authority in Civil Appeal No. 949 of 2006.

6. In case, any participant joining the DVC, is unable to complete his/her submission for any technical reason, he/she may file written submission which will be taken on record. Further, all written submissions will be shared amongst all participating interested parties as per the usual practice so as to enable all interested parties to file rejoinders. The time schedule for written submissions and rejoinders will be informed during the oral hearing.
7. The concerned Embassies/Country representative offices in India are requested to encourage/facilitate participation of the interested parties from their country in the oral hearing through DVC.
