**NOTICE FOR ORAL HEARING**

**Subject: Oral hearing in Anti-subsidy investigation concerning imports of “Aluminium Wire /Wire Rods above 7 mm dia” originating in or exported from Malaysia.**

Sir/Madam,

An Anti-subsidy investigation concerning imports of “Aluminium Wire /Wire Rods above 7 mm dia” originating in or exported from Malaysia was initiated on 30.06.2020 under the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Countervailing duty on Subsidized Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995. As per Rule 7 (6) of the CVD Rules “*The Designated Authority may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing*”.

2. In pursuance of the aforesaid provision and the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic, the Designated Authority has scheduled an oral hearing in the matter through digital video conference (DVC) on **NIC-WEBEX MEETINGS** platform on **28<sup>th</sup> May 2021 at 02:30 PM (IST)**.

Further, all written submissions will be shared amongst all participating interested parties as per the usual practice so as to enable all interested parties to file rejoinders. The time schedule for written submissions and rejoinders will be informed during the oral hearing.
7. The concerned Embassy/Country representative offices in India are requested to encourage/facilitate participation of the interested parties from their country in the oral hearing through DVC.
