**Subject: Extension of applicability of Countervailing duty on imports of ‘Saccharin’
originating in or exported from China PR- regarding.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to DGTR letter F. No. 7/34/2023-DGTR dated 26th April, 2024 on the above subject and to inform that with the approval of the competent authority, the countervailing duty imposed vide notification No. 2/2019-Customs (CVD) dated 30th August, 2019, has been extended upto and inclusive of 28th February, 2025 vide notification No. 02/2024-Customs (CVD) dated 28th May, 2024 and accordingly, in terms of Rule 24 of the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Countervailing Duty on Subsidized Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995, the time period for completing the subject investigation stands extended upto 30th November, 2024, that is, three months prior to the expiry of the countervailing duty under review.
