**NOTICE FOR 2<sup>nd</sup> ORAL HEARING**

**Subject: 2nd Oral Hearing of Sunset Review of Anti-Dumping Duty investigation concerning imports of “Melamine” from China PR.**

Third Sunset review of Anti-Dumping investigation on imports of “Melamine” was initiated on 22.09.2020.

2. As per Rule 6 (6) of AD Rules “*The Designated Authority may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing*”.
3. In pursuance of the aforesaid provision, 1st Oral Hearing was held on 16.11.2020 wherein the interested parties filed written and rejoinder submissions also.
4. The second Oral Hearing has been necessitated due to the reason that **Shri B.B. Swain, IAS**, the then Designated Authority at the time of first oral Hearing held on 16.11.2020, has been succeeded by **Shri Anant Swarup, JS, Designated Authority**. This development mandates that a new oral hearing be held by new Authority as per the judgement of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the matter of Automotive Tyre Manufactureres Association (ATMA) vs. The Designated Authority & ors in Civil Appeal No. 949 of 2006 dated 17.01.2011.
5. The new Designated Authority has scheduled **2<sup>nd</sup> Oral Hearing** in the matter through Digital Video Conference (DVC) via NIC WebEx to be held on **11.02.2021 at 16:30 hrs. (IST)**.
