Subject: Oral Hearing in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Cold rolled / cold reduced flat steel products of iron or non-alloy steel, or other alloy steel, of all widths and thickness, not clad, plated or coated”, originating in or exported from China PR, Japan, Korea RP and Ukraine-reg.

This is in reference to the letter dated 22nd December, 2016 in regard to the Second Oral Hearing on 30th December, 2016, which has been necessitated due to the reason that Shri A.K. Bhalla, who was the Designated Authority at the time of first Oral Hearing held on 13th October, 2016, has been succeeded by Dr. Inder Jit Singh, Additional Secretary, Deptt of Commerce, w.e.f. 21st October, 2016. This development mandates that a new public hearing be held by the new Designated Authority as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Automotive Tyre Manufacturers' Association (ATMA) vs. Designated Authority, delivered in Civil Appeal No. 949 of 2006 on 07-01-2011.

It is for your information that the Oral Hearing which was scheduled to be held at 1:30 PM on 30th December, 2016 has now been postponed in view of the requests made by Solicitors namely, (i) DGS Associates representing POSCO, Korea (ii) Economic Law practice, Advocates & Solicitors representing many Exporters, Producers & Importers and (iii) KNM & Partners, Law Offices representing Maruti Suzuki India Limited. The oral hearing will now be held at **1:30 PM on 10th January, 2017** in the DGAD Conference Room, Jeevan Tara Building, 4th floor, 5 Parliament Street, New Delhi -110 001
