Subject: Oral Hearing in Anti-Circumvention investigation concerning imports of "Cold-Rolled Flat Products of Stainless Steel" originating in or exported from China PR, Korea, European Union, South Africa, Taiwan, Thailand and USA – Pursuant to Final order No. 51204-51205/2019 dated 12/09/2019 by the Hon'ble CESTAT passed in Appeal No. 50291/2018 (M/s Jindal Stainless Limited vs. Designated Authority) and Appeal No. 50334/2018 (M/s Jindal Stainless Hisar Limited vs. Designated Authority).

This is for your information that in the above mentioned investigation, the Designated Authority will hold a **Second Oral Hearing on 03.12.2019 at 02:00 pm** in the Conference Room, DGTR, 4th Floor, Jeevan Tara Building, 5, Parliament Street, New Delhi-110001.

2. The said Second Oral Hearing has been necessitated due to the reasons that the then Designated Authority (present at the time of First Oral Hearing held on 30.10.2019 at 03:00 PM) has been replaced **by the new Designated Authority, Shri B. S. Bhalla**, Additional Secretary. This development mandates that an Oral hearing be held by the new Designated Authority as per the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Automotive Tyre Manufacturers' Association (ATMA) vs. Designated Authority, delivered in Civil Appeal No. 949 of 2006 on 07-01-2011.

It may be noted that, as directed by Hon'ble CESTAT vide its Order dated 12.09.2019, this Oral Hearing is being conducted for the limited purpose of re-examining the issue whether the anti-dumping duty in the anti-circumvention final finding should be levied retrospectively from the date of initiation of the anti-circumvention investigation or from the date of publication by the Central Government in the Gazette.

You will be required to submit two (02) copies of the written submissions along with the soft copy of the views expressed at the Oral Hearing within the time schedule to be indicated on the date of Oral Hearing.

5. Please take note of the above mentioned schedule and adhere to the same. Since anti-dumping investigations are time bound, no extension in the Oral Hearing date will be allowed.
