**Subject – Anti-dumping investigation concerning imports Aluminium Foil originating in or exported from China PR.**

1. Reference of all interested parties is invited to the above-cited investigation. The Authority had, on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2024, initiated the said anti-dumping investigation vide Notification F. No. 6/35/2023-DGTR.
2. The Authority finalized the scope of PUC and PCN methodology and notified vide notification dated 6<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Accordingly, the Authority requested all interested parties to file questionnaire responses by 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and subsequently extended the time to file the response till 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024.
3. In view of large number of producers and traders who have responded in the present investigation, the Authority, pursuant to Rule 17(3) of the AD Rules, has selected the following three (3) producers alongwith their associated exporters for determination of individual dumping margin, on the basis of the largest percentage of the volume of the exports to India from China PR during the investigation period, and considering number of producers that can be investigated for individual determination of dumping margin
  - i. Sunho New Materials Technology Co., Ltd.
  - ii. Henan Mingtai Technology Development Co., Ltd
  - iii. Shandong Deli Aluminium Technology Co., Ltd
4. The Authority would determine the dumping margin for non-sampled cooperating producers/ exporters from China PR on the basis of dumping margin of the sampled producers from China PR, and in accordance with the provisions of the Rules.
5. The interested parties may offer their comments latest by 16<sup>th</sup> Aug., 2024. In view of time bound nature of anti-dumping investigations, no request for extension of time shall be entertained by the Authority.
6. This issues with the approval of the Designated Authority.
