NOTICE FOR ORAL HEARING

Subject: Oral Hearing in the matter of anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of "Metronidazole" originating in or exported from China PR.

Sir/Madam,

The Authority had initiated an anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of "Metronidazole" originating in or exported from China PR on 30.09.2022, under the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-dumping duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995. As per Rule 6 (6) of the Anti-dumping Rules, 1995, "*The Designated Authority may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing*".

2. In pursuance of the aforesaid provision, the Designated Authority has scheduled an oral hearing in the aforesaid matter through digital video conference (DVC) over **WEBEX** platform on **03rd February 2023 at 3:00 PM (IST)**.
3. The details for participation in the said oral hearing are attached below in **Annex - 1**. Interested parties may participate in the oral hearing in case they wish to present any such information before the Designated Authority which is relevant to the investigation.

Technical details for participation in the oral hearing in the matter of Anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Metronidazole “originating in or exported from China PR on 3rd February, 2023 at 03:00 PM (IST).

1. The oral hearing would be convened through digital video conference (DVC) via **WEBEX MEETINGS** in accordance with the Trade Notice 01/2020 dated 10.04.2020, uploaded on DGTR's website at <https://www.dgtr.gov.in/sites/default/files/Trade%20Notice%20Covid%2019.pdf>

An interested party who wishes to join the DVC should provide **name of the organization/company, e-mail, mobile no., landline no., (with country/state code), name and email-id of the participating legal representative/coordinator well in advance** at the email address adg14-dgtr@gov.in and dd11-dgtr@gov.in. **It is directed that the ‘screen names’ of the participants during the said DVC must be mentioned correctly including the name of the person and the organization they are representing.** Inaccurate mentioning of screen names may lead to cancellation of participation in the oral hearing by the coordinator.

5. As submissions are to be subsequently reproduced in writing by each interested party after the oral hearing, the interested parties are requested to be brief and restrict their oral submissions to essential aspects only.
6. In case, any participant joining the DVC, is not able to complete their submissions for any technical reason they may file written submissions which will be taken on record. Further, all written submissions will be shared amongst all participating interested parties as per the usual practice so as to enable all interested parties to file rejoinders. The time schedule for written submissions and rejoinders will be informed during the oral hearing.
7. The concerned Embassy/country representative offices in India are requested to encourage/facilitate participation of the interested parties from their country in the said oral hearing through DVC.
