**SCOPE OF THE PRODUCT UNDER CONSIDERATION AND PRODUCT
CONTROL NUMBERS**

Subject: Scope of the product under consideration and product control numbers in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of 'Thermoplastic Polyurethane (TPU)' originating in or exported from China PR.

1. Reference of all interested parties is invited to the above-cited subject. The Authority had, on 29th September 2023, initiated the said anti-dumping investigation vide Notification F. No. 6/23/2023-DGTR, wherein the product under consideration (hereinafter referred to as 'PUC') was defined in Section A of the notification and an excerpt of details of the PUC is indicated as under:

"3. The product under consideration is "Thermoplastic Polyurethane" ("TPU") originating in or exported from China PR. TPU is a melt-processable thermoplastic elastomer having unique properties of plastic and rubber, including elasticity, transparency, and resistance to oil, grease, and abrasion. TPU is thermoplastic elastomer consisting of linear segmented block copolymer composed of hard and soft segments. PUC covers TPU in the form of powder, granules, pellets, unmodified or modified by colourants, fillers or other additives.

2. The non-confidential version of the application filed by the domestic industry was circulated to all interested parties vide email and letter dated 10th October 2023. The interested parties were granted an opportunity to present their comments on the scope of the PUC and propose PCNs, if required, within a period of 15 days from the date of the circulation of the non-confidential version of application which ended on 24th October 2023. No comments and proposals for PUC and the construction of PCNs have been received. **Hence there is no change in PUC and no PCN methodology is adopted for the present investigation.**

3. Accordingly, all the interested parties i.e. producers/exporters/importers/users etc., are requested to file the respective questionnaire responses within the stipulated time of 30 days from

the date of this circular. Responses not filed within the stipulated time will be treated as per Section N of the Initiation Notification.

5. As trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted in the captioned matter.
6. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
