Corrigendum Notification

Subject: Initiation of Anti-dumping duty investigation concerning imports of “Meta-Phenylene Diamene-4-Sulphonic Acid (MPDSA)” originating in or exported from People’s Republic of China.

F. No.06/35/2017-DGAD: Having regard to the Customs Tariff Act, 1975, as amended from time to time (hereinafter also referred to as the Act), and the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-Dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995, as amended from time to time, (hereinafter also referred to as the Rules) thereof, the Designated Authority has issued the Initiation Notification, vide notification No. 06/35/2017-DGAD dated 24.01.2018 in respect of subject Anti-dumping investigation.

Para 16 of the notice of initiation is substituted as under:

“The petitioners have proposed 2016-17 as the period of investigation for this investigation. However, in order to have more recent data, the Authority has decided the period of 15 months (April, 2016 to June, 2017) as the period of investigation. The injury investigation period will, however, cover the periods April 2013 – March 2014, April 2014 – March 2015, April 2015 – March 2016 and the POI.”
