Subject: Sunset Review Investigation of Antidumping duty concerning imports of Nylon Filament Yarn originating in or exported from China PR, Chinese Taipei, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand and Korea RP

Dear Madam/Sir,

This has reference to the subject anti-dumping investigation initiated by the Directorate General of Anti-Dumping & Allied Duties (DGAD) on 9th January, 2017.

In this regard, it has been noticed that subject goods are manufactured and exported in various grades/types. Therefore, in order to have proper grade to grade comparison for calculating dumping margin and injury margin, it is proposed to follow the following PCN methodology:

S. No	Characteristic	Format	Explanation
1.	Filaments	XXX	The first 3 digits in the PCN should denote the number of filaments. The number of filaments may vary from 1 to 144.
2.	Denier	XXX	The next 3 digits in the PCN should denote Denier. Denier refers to the thickness of the yarn and expressed in numbers. For eg: a) 15 Denier:- 015 b) 20 Denier :- 020 c) 100 Denier:- 100 etc
3.	Luster	XX	The next 2 digits in the PCN should denote luster which may be bright, dull etc. a) Bright: "BR" b) Semi dull: "SD" c) Full Dull: "FD" d) Other than above: "OT"
4.	Colour	XX	Next two digits to show whether the product is grey or coloured. GR= Grey (natural Colour) DY= Dyed (Coloured) UN= Unidentified

For example, PCN for Grey Mono Filament with Semi dull luster having 20 denier will be "001020SDGR" and Dyed 40 Filament with Bright luster having 15 denier will be "040015BRDY".

In case any party has any comments on the PCN methodology, the same may be submitted by 26th September 2017.

All interested parties are required to provide PCN wise information by 29th September, 2017.
