Scope of the Product Under Consideration and Product Control Numbers

Subject: Scope of the product under consideration and product control numbers in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Thiram in any form” originating in or exported from the European Union.

1. All interested parties are requested to refer to the subject investigation. The Authority had initiated the said anti-dumping investigation vide Notification F. No. -6/18/2024-DGTR dated 29th June 2024, wherein the product under consideration (hereinafter referred to as ‘PUC’) was defined and an excerpt of the details of the PUC is indicated as under:

“3. The product under consideration in the present investigation is Thiram in any form including its technical and formulation form.

4. Thiram is used as a fungicide to prevent crop damage in the field and to prevent crops from deterioration in storage or transport. Thiram is also used as a seed, nut, fruit, and mushroom disinfectant from a variety of fungal diseases. In addition, it is used as an animal repellent to protect fruit trees and ornamentals from damage by rabbits, rodents, and deer. Thiram has been used in the treatment of human scabies, as a sunscreen, and as a bactericide applied directly to the skin or incorporated into soap.

5. The product under consideration is classified under Chapter 38 of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 under heading 3808 92 30 of the Tariff Classification. The product under consideration has a dedicated classification. The customs classification is only indicative and the same is not binding on the scope of the investigation.”

2. The non-confidential version of the application filed by the domestic industry was circulated to all interested parties. The interested parties were granted an opportunity to offer their comments on the scope of the PUC and propose PCNs, if required, within a period of 30 days from the date of initiation. Subsequently, the Authority held a meeting to discuss the scope of PUC and PCN methodology on 14.08.24.
3. Comments were received from certain interested parties. The Authority has taken note of the submissions of all the interested parties regarding the scope of PUC & PCN methodology and hereby, informs that there is no change in PUC as notified in the initiation notification.
4. The applicant had proposed the following PCN methodology. Based on the discussion held with the interested parties, the Authority adopts the PCN methodology as proposed by the applicant Industry.

1	Thiram Technical	“TT”
2	Thiram Formulation	“TF”

5. In view of the above, all interested parties are requested to file questionnaire response in accordance with the above PCN methodology within 15 days of the issuance of this notice. No extension of time will be granted by the Authority to file the questionnaire response. As trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted in the captioned matter.
