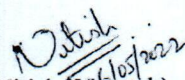

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Anti-Dumping investigation concerning imports of Melamine from the European Union, Japan, Qatar and the United Arab Emirates - regarding

The undersigned is directed to refer to anti-dumping investigation final findings on the above subject issued *vide* notification F. No. 6/1/2021-DGTR, dated the 25th February, 2022, wherein it was recommended to impose definite anti-dumping duty on imports of "Melamine" originating in or exported from European Union, Japan, Qatar and the United Arab Emirates.

2. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (5) of section 9A of the Customs Tariff Act, read with rules 18 and 20 of the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995, the Central Government, after considering the final findings of the designated authority, has decided not to accept the aforesaid recommendations.
