NOTIFICATION

Subject: Anti-dumping investigations concerning import of Acrylic Fibre originating in or exported from Egypt – Termination of investigation.

No. 14/18/2013-DGAD - Having regard to the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 and the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti Dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995, thereof :

2. BACKGROUND


- i. The Designated Authority (hereinafter referred to as Authority), under the above Rules, received a written petition from M/s Indian Acrylics Ltd., Chandigarh and M/s Pasupati Acrylon Ltd., Delhi alleging dumping of Acrylic Fibre originating in or exported from Egypt (hereinafter referred to as subject country).
- ii. The Authority on the basis of sufficient evidence submitted by the petitioners decided to initiate investigations against alleged dumping of imports of Acrylic Fibre originating in or exported from Egypt. The Authority notified the Embassy of the subject country about the receipt of dumping allegation before proceeding to initiate investigations in accordance with sub-rule 5(5) of the Rules.
- iii. The Authority issued a Public Notice dated 24th February 2014 published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary initiating anti dumping investigations concerning imports of Acrylic Fibre classified under Chapter 55 of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 originating in or exported from the subject country.
- iv. The Authority forwarded a copy of the Public Notice to the known exporter, whose details were made available by the petitioners, and gave them an opportunity to make their views known in writing within forty days from the date of the letter.
- v. The period of investigation for the purpose of the present investigations was 1st April, 2012 to 30th September, 2013 (18 months).

3. SUBMISSION BY DOMESTIC INDUSTRY

The Domestic Industry vide its letter dated 23rd December 2014, has stated that the sole producer of Acrylic Fibre in Egypt has since stopped production and it does not appear necessary to request imposition of anti dumping duty on imports of Acrylic Fibre from Egypt. Accordingly they have requested that their application for the above mentioned Anti-dumping investigation be treated as withdrawn in terms of Rule 14(a)

4. CONCLUSIONS

In view of the aforesaid submission by the Domestic Industry, the Designated Authority under the provisions of Rule 14 of Rules supra hereby terminates the aforesaid investigation initiated vide notification No.14/18/2013-DGAD dated 24th February, 2014 against imports of Acrylic Fibre originating in or exported from Egypt.
