Subject: PCN methodology in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of Para Nitrotoluene (PNT) originating in or exported from the European Union.

Sir/Ma'am,

Reference is invited to the above-cited subject. The Authority had on 30th September 2024, initiated the subject anti-dumping investigation vide Notification F. No. 6/35/2024-DGTR, wherein the product under consideration (hereinafter referred to as "PUC") was defined as under:

"The product under consideration in the present application is Para Nitrotoluene (PNT). The product is also known as Paranitrotoluol, 4-Methylnitrobenzene, 1-Methyl-4-nitrobenzene, pMethylnitrobenzene or 4-Nitrotoluene. The Chemical Abstracts Service (CAS) Registry Number for the product is 99-99-0.

The other interested parties were asked to provide their comments on the scope of the product under consideration within 15 days of initiation of the investigation. Apart from domestic industry, M/s ASL Legal has filed their comments on PUC/PCN on behalf of M/s LANXESS Deutschland GmbH, producer / exporter from Germany & M/s LANXESS India Private Limited, India. After examination of comments received on PUC/PCN, it is decided that there is no requirement of PCN in the present investigation. Therefore, the scope of the product under consideration is considered same as defined in the initiation notification. It is also decided that there is no need for any PCN methodology.

Interested parties are directed to file their responses based on the above product under consideration within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.
