Subject: Suo-motu anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of ‘Fasteners’ originating in or exported from China PR.

Sir/Madam,

1. With respect to the above-mentioned investigation, letters were sent post-initiation on 6th December 2023 to known interested parties containing details about various submissions, including the opportunity to submit their comments on the scope of the PUC and propose PCNs, if any, within 15 days from the date of the said letter.
2. Requests were received from a few interested parties for granting an extension of the timeline for filing comments on the scope of the PUC and PCNs. Based on the requests, the Authority extended the above timeline till 27th December 2023.
3. A number of interested parties have submitted comments on the scope of the PUC and PCNs and few have also sought extension of deadline to file questionnaire responses.
4. The comments on PUC and PCNs are under examination by the Authority. If required, a meeting with all the aforesaid interested parties will be held for discussion on the scope of the PUC and PCNs.
4. The final PCN methodology will be published on DGTR’s website, and all the interested parties will be provided a reasonable time to file their respective questionnaire responses.
