Subject: PCN methodology in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of 2,2,4-trimethyl-1,2-dihydroquinoline (TDQ) originating in or exported from China PR.

Sir/Ma'am,

The Authority had on 27th December 2024, initiated the above-mentioned subject vide Notification F. No. 6/51/2024-DGTR, wherein the product under consideration (hereinafter referred to as "PUC") was defined as under:

“The product under consideration in the present investigation is ‘2,2,4-trimethyl-1,2-dihydroquinoline’, also known as ‘TDQ’.”

The other interested parties were asked to provide their comments on the scope of the product under consideration within 15 days of initiation of the investigation. No comments have been received from any of the interested parties and therefore it is decided that the scope of the product under consideration is same as defined in the initiation. Further, there is no requirement of PCN in the present investigation.
