Subject: Finalisation of scope of the product under consideration (PUC) and product control number (PCN) methodology and filing of Questionnaire responses – reg.

Reference: Anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Ethylene Diamine” originating in or exported from China PR, European Union, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Taiwan.

1. Attention of all the interested parties is invited to the above-mentioned investigation initiated *vide* initiation notification No. 6/05/2025-DGTR dated 25th March, 2025. Whereby, the interested parties were granted an opportunity to present their comments on the scope of the product under consideration (PUC), and product control number (PCN) methodology, within a period of 15 days from the date of the initiation notification. The other interested party requested for extension to file comments on the scope of PUC. On reviewing the request, the Authority granted additional 7 days from the date of extension notification. In this regard, the deadline for filing comments on the scope of PUC and PCN methodology extended from 9th April 2025 to 23rd April 2025.
2. The Authority has received comments from domestic industry and other interested parties on the scope of the PUC and PCN methodology within the prescribed time limits.
3. After examining the comments/ submissions submitted by interested parties, the Authority is of the opinion that there is no sufficient ground for any exclusions or to make PCN in present investigation. The scope of the product under consideration thus remains the same as notified in the initiation notification No. 6/05/2025-DGTR dated 25th March, 2025 without any change.
4. Accordingly, all interested parties are requested to file their respective questionnaire responses within **30 days** from the date of this notification i.e., **30th May, 2025** in accordance with the Section K of the initiation notification. Responses not filed within the stipulated timelines will be treated as per Section N (*Non-Cooperation*) of the initiation notification.
5. As trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
6. This issues with the approval of the Designated Authority.
