Corrigendum Notification

Subject: Initiation of anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of Isononanol (INA) originating in or exported from European Union and Singapore, 2-Propylheptyl Alcohol (2-PH) originating in or exported from European Union and 2-Ethyl Hexanol (2-EH) originating in or exported from Saudi Arabia and Singapore.

F.No.14/22/2016-DGAD: Having regard to the Customs Tariff Act, 1975, as amended from time to time (hereinafter also referred to as the Act), and the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-Dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995, as amended from time to time, (hereinafter also referred to as the Rules) thereof, the Designated Authority has issued an initiation notification vide Notification No. 14/22/2016-DGAD dated 9th July, 2019 in respect of subject Anti-Dumping investigation.

Under Para 12 of the said Notification, the following line is added at the end of the para.

“The injury investigation period will however cover the periods April’15-March’16, April’16-March’17, April’17-March’18 and the period of investigation.”
