**NOTICE FOR THE FRESH ORAL HEARING**

**Subject: Fresh Oral Hearing in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of '4,4 Diamino Stilbene 2, 2 Disulphonic Acid (DASDA)' originating in or exported from China PR**

1. The Authority had initiated an anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of '4,4 Diamino Stilbene 2, 2 Disulphonic Acid (DASDA)' originating in or exported from China PR on 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 under the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-dumping duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995 (AD Rules). As per Rule 6 (6) of the AD Rules *"The Designated Authority may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing"*.
2. In pursuance of the aforesaid provision, the Designated Authority has scheduled an oral hearing on Monday, **16<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 at 5:00 PM (IST)**. The hearing will be held in hybrid mode i.e., both through Digital Video Conferencing (DVC) and physically in the conference room of DGTR at the above address.
3. The fresh Oral Hearing is being held due to the change of Designated Authority.
