Subject: - Final PUC/PCN methodology – anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of Low Ash Metallurgical Coke originating in or exported from Australia, China, Colombia, Indonesia, Japan and Russia.

1. This has reference to the initiation notification no. 6/03/2025-DGTR dated 29th March 2025 *vide* which comments were invited from all interested parties on the scope of the PUC and PCN methodology proposed by the applicant. A meeting was held on 22nd May 2025 with the interested parties to discuss and understand the comments made on the scope of the product under consideration and the PCN methodology. All comments received from the interested parties have been examined.
2. After considering the submissions made by the interested parties, it is clarified that the scope of the PUC remains the same as defined in the initiation notification. Further, the Authority has adopted the following PCN methodology for the present investigation.
