**Subject: Extension of the timeline for filing the questionnaire responses by the interested parties pertaining to the countervailing duty investigation concerning imports of “Clear Float Glass” originating in or exported from Malaysia and Indonesia.**

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation *vide* Initiation Notification No. 6/36/2025-DGTR, dated 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2025.
2. As per the Notice dated 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2025, regarding the finalisation of the scope of the PUC/PCN methodology and the submission of questionnaire responses, all interested parties i.e., producers/ exporters/ importers/ users, etc. were required to submit their respective questionnaire responses within 37 days from the date of intimation by Letter/E-mail i.e. 03.10.2025.
3. In response to requests from certain interested parties seeking an extension of the timeline to file questionnaire responses, the requests have been duly considered, and the deadline has been decided to be extended until 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2025.
4. Since the trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
