**Subject: Extension of statutory deadline for completion of anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of 'Monoisopropylamine (MIPA)' originating in or exported from China PR**

1. It is hereby notified that, in respect of the ongoing anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of 'Monoisopropylamine (MIPA)' originating in or exported from China PR, the Central Government has extended the statutory time limit for completion of the investigation by a further period of three months, beyond 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2025, i.e. up to 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2026, in terms of the applicable provisions of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 and the Anti-Dumping Rules, 1995.
2. The above extension has been granted by the Central Government vide Office Memorandum No. CBIC-190349/61/2025-TRU Section-CBIC dated 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2025, issued by the Tax Research Unit (TRU), Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance.
3. In accordance with the above extension granted by the Central Government, the **Designated Authority has accordingly revised the schedule for completion of the subject investigation**, which shall now be concluded **on or before 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2026**.
