**Subject: Extension of statutory timeline for completion of anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of "Sulphenamides Accelerators" originating and exported from China PR, European Union and United States of America.**

1. It is hereby notified that, in respect of the ongoing anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of 'Sulphenamides Accelerators' originating and exported from China PR, European Union and United States of America, the Central Government has extended the statutory time limit for completion of the investigation by a further period of three months, beyond 30th December, 2025, i.e. up to 30th March, 2026, in terms of the applicable provisions of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 and the Anti-Dumping Rules, 1995.
2. The above extension has been granted by the Central Government vide Office Memorandum No. CBIC-190349/69/2025-TRU Section-CBIC dated 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2025, issued by the Tax Research Unit (TRU), Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance.
3. In accordance with the above extension granted by the Central Government, the **Designated Authority has accordingly revised the schedule for completion of the subject investigation**, which shall now be concluded **on or before 30th March, 2026**.
