1. Reference of all interested parties is invited to the above-cited investigation. The Authority had, on 29 September 2025, initiated the said countervailing investigation vide notification no. 6/35/2025-DGTR.
2. In view of large number of producers/exporters from subject countries who have responded in the present investigation, the Authority has selected the following producers including their related parties for determination of individual subsidy margin, on the basis of the largest percentage of the volume of exports to India during the investigation period, and considering number of producers that can reasonably be investigated for determination of individual subsidy margin-
