**NOTICE FOR ORAL HEARING**

**Subject: Oral Hearing in the matter of Anti-dumping Investigation concerning imports of "Copper Data Cables" originating in or exported from the People's Republic of China.**

Sir/Madam,

1. The Authority had initiated an **Anti-dumping Investigation concerning imports of "Copper Data Cables" originating in or exported from the People's Republic of China** on 18th September, 2025 under the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-Dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995. As per Rule 6 (6) of the ADD Rules;

*“The Designated Authority may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing”*

2. In pursuance of the aforesaid provision, the Designated Authority has scheduled an oral hearing on **23rd January, 2026 at 3:30 PM (IST)**. The hearing will be held in hybrid mode i.e., both through Digital Video Conferencing (DVC) and physically in the conference room of DGTR.
