**Subject –Sampling in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Melamine” originating in or exported from China PR-regd**

1. Reference of all interested parties is invited to the above-mentioned investigation. The Authority initiated the subject investigation vide notification no. 6/40/2025-DGTR dated 29.09.2025.
2. In view of large number of producers and traders who have participated in the subject investigation, the Authority, pursuant to Rule 17(3) of the AD Rules has selected the following three (3) producers along with their associated exporters for determination of dumping margin, on the basis of the largest percentage of the volume of the exports to India from China PR during the period of investigation (POI), which can reasonably be investigated for individual determination of dumping margin-
  - i. **Xinjiang Yihua Group** comprising the following producers/ exporters - Xinjiang Yihua Chemical Industry Co., Ltd., M/s Yihua (Xinjiang) Material Trade Co., Ltd. and Hubei Yihua International Trading Co. Ltd.
  - ii. **Xinjiang Xinlianxin Group** comprising the following producers/exporters- Xinjiang Xinlianxin Energy Chemical Co., Ltd., Harvest International Business Ltd. and Henan Xinlianxin International Trading Co., Ltd.
  - iii. **Huaqiang Chemical Group** comprising producer/exporter- Huaqiang Chemical Group Stock Co., Ltd.
3. The Authority would determine the dumping margin for non-sampled cooperating producers/ exporters from China PR on the basis of dumping margin of the sampled producers from China PR, and in accordance with the provisions of the Rules.

4. The interested parties may offer their comments within 7 days of the issuance of this notice, i.e.,30.01.2026. In view of time bound nature of anti-dumping investigations, no request for extension of time shall be entertained by the Authority.
5. This is issued with the approval of the Designated Authority.
