Notice of Proposed Sampling of Producers/Exporters

Subject: Anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Medical Examination Rubber Gloves” originating in or exported from Malaysia and Thailand – Proposed sampling of producers/exporters from Malaysia – reg.

1. Reference is invited to the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of *Medical Examination Rubber Gloves* originating in or exported from Malaysia and Thailand, initiated vide Notification No. 6/43/2025-DGTR dated 30.09.2025.
2. In the present investigation, four (04) producers/exporters from Malaysia have filed questionnaire responses.
3. The Authority notes that the Product Under Consideration involves a large number of Product Control Numbers (PCNs), resulting in substantial complexity in transaction-wise analysis, cost examination and price comparisons. Examination of all responding producers/exporters along with their associated entities would significantly increase the volume of verification and analysis and may affect timely completion of the investigation.
4. Accordingly, in terms of Rule 17(3) of the Anti-Dumping Rules, 1995, the Authority proposes to limit the determination of individual dumping margin to a reasonable number of producers/exporters accounting for the largest percentage of exports from the Malaysia which can reasonably be investigated.
5. Based on the information available on record, the Authority proposes to select the following producers/exporters from Malaysia along with their associated exporters/traders for individual determination of dumping margin:

Malaysia:

- i. Hartalega Group, *comprising producer/exporter - MUN Global SDN BHD*
- ii. Top Glove Group, *comprising producer/exporter - Top Glove Medical, Top Glove SDN BHD, Top Glove Worldwide*

6. The Authority proposes to determine the dumping margin for non-sampled cooperating producers/exporters, if any, on the basis of the weighted average dumping margin established for the sampled producers/exporters, in accordance with the provisions of the Rules.
7. Interested parties may submit their comments, duly substantiated with evidence, if any, on the proposed sampling **by 28th February, 2026**. In view of the time-bound nature of anti-dumping investigations, no request for extension of time shall ordinarily be entertained.
8. This issues with the approval of the Designated Authority.

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
