Subject: Notification for clarifying the PUC/PCN methodology in the Anti-Dumping investigation concerning imports of “Nylon 6 Chips and Granules with relative viscosity (RV) below 3” originating in or exported from China PR and Russia.

1. This has reference to the above cited subject. The Authority, on 31st December 2025, initiated the subject anti-dumping investigation vide Notification no F. No. 6/60/2025-DGTR, wherein the PUC was defined and as excerpt of the same is as under:

“3. The product under consideration in the present application is “Nylon 6 (Polyamide 6) Chips and Granules with relative viscosity (RV) below 3.”

4. The product under consideration is primarily used for textile applications but may also be suitable for light-duty non-textile applications such as automotive and electrical industries.

Exclusion

5. The product in powder form is specifically excluded from the scope of product under consideration.”

2. The interested parties were advised to provide their comments on the scope of the product under consideration within 15 days from date of receiving intimation letter regarding the said investigation.
3. Comments and proposals by interested parties were received and after examining all submissions made, the Authority clarifies that the scope of PUC is same as provided above in paragraph 1 of this notice.
4. With regard to the PCN methodology, based on the examination of submissions received from the interested parties, the Authority hereby adopts the PCN methodology as mentioned in the table below:

5. In view of the above, all interested parties are requested to file their questionnaire responses for the scope of the product under consideration set out above and in accordance with the above mentioned PCN-methodology within **15 days** of the publication of this Notification.
