**Subject: Extension of the timeline for filing the questionnaire responses by the interested parties pertaining to the countervailing duty investigation concerning imports of "PVC Suspension Resins" from China PR.**

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation *vide* Initiation Notification No. 06/67/2025-DGTR, dated 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2026.
2. As per the circulated letter/e-mail dated 27.02.2026, all interested parties i.e., producers/exporters/importers/users, etc. were required to submit their questionnaire responses within 37 days from the date of circulation, i.e., by 04.04.2026. Further, as per the Notice dated 2nd April, 2026 regarding the finalization of the scope of the PUC/PCN methodology, the questionnaire responses were required to be submitted in accordance with the finalized PUC/PCN by 19.04.2026.
3. In response to requests from certain interested parties seeking an extension of the timeline to file questionnaire responses, the requests have been duly considered, and the deadline has been decided to be extended until 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.
4. Since the trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
