Subject: Extension for filing Questionnaire responses in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “1-(3,5,5,6,8,8-hexamethyl-6,7-dihydronaphthalen-2-yl) ethenone” originating in or exported from China PR. - reg.

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation vide Initiation Notification No. 6/14/2026-DGTR dated 19th March, 2026.
2. As per the above-mentioned Notice regarding the finalisation of the scope of the PUC/PCN methodology and the submission of questionnaire responses, all interested parties i.e., producers/ exporters/ importers/ users, etc. were required to submit their respective questionnaire responses within 37 days (i.e. 29th April, 2026) from the date of intimation by E-mail i.e. 23rd March, 2026.
3. In response to requests from certain interested parties seeking an extension of the timeline to file questionnaire responses, the requests have been duly considered, and it has been decided to **extend the deadline until 14th May, 2026.**
4. Since the trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
