**Subject: PUC/PCN methodology in the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “1-(3,5,5,6,8,8-hexamethyl-6,7-dihydronaphthalen-2-yl) ethenone” originating in or exported from China PR.**

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation vide Initiation Notification No. 6/14/2026-DGTR dated 19th March, 2026.
2. Comments were invited by the authority on the scope of PUC/PCN methodology within 15 days of date of initiation of the subject investigation.
3. No comments with regard to the scope of PUC and PCN have been received from any interested party within the stipulated time and therefore, the authority adopts the same PUC/PCN as mentioned in the initiation Notification.
