Subject: Extension of the timeline for filing the questionnaire responses by the interested parties pertaining to the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Thermal Paper or Thermal Sensitive Paper” originating in or exported from the United States of America, China PR, and the Republic of Korea – reg.

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation vide Initiation Notification No. 06/25/2026-DGTR (Case No. AD(OI)-25/2026), dated 24th June, 2026.
2. Further, Further, all interested parties were directed to file their questionnaire response within 37 days from the date of intimation of the email dated 25th June 2026, i.e. by 31st July 2026.
3. However, certain interested parties have requested for extension of timelines for filing the questionnaire responses. The requests have been duly considered, and it has been decided to extend the timeline for filing the questionnaire responses by the interested parties till **14th August, 2026**.
4. It is also to note that, an extension of time by 15 days shall be granted if the Authority, through a subsequent notice, modifies the PUC and PCN that was not previously proposed or is different from the initiation notification. This extension of 15 days shall be granted from date of such notification of modified PUC and PCN.
5. Since the trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
