Subject: Extension of statutory deadline for completion of anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Nylon 6 in any form, with relative viscosity of RV-3.0 to 3.6” originating in or exported from China PR, Russia, Taiwan and Thailand.

1. It is hereby notified that, in respect of the ongoing anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of **“Nylon 6 in any form, with relative viscosity of Rv-3.0 to 3.6” originating in or exported from China PR, Russia, Taiwan and Thailand**, the Central Government has extended the statutory time limit for completion of the investigation by a further period of **three months beyond 29th September, 2026, i.e. up to 29th December, 2026**, in terms of the applicable provisions of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 and the Anti-Dumping Rules, 1995.
2. The above extension has been granted by the Central Government vide **Office Memorandum F. No. CBIC- 190354/129/2026-TO (TRU-I)-CBEC dated 21st September, 2026**, issued by the Tax Research Unit (TRU), Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Government of India.
3. In accordance with the above extension granted by the Central Government, the Designated Authority has accordingly revised the schedule for completion of the subject investigation, which shall now be concluded **on or before 29th December, 2026**.

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
